

It's the best and most organized book on sight reading I've ever seen, including Buddy Rich's Rudiments, and Ted Reed's Syncopation. I have no idea why it's not enormously popular. No other sight reading and rudiment book I've ever used has the perfection of this book. The explanations are clear and concise, and the scaffolding from one concept to the next is flawless. This is the only sight reading book I use with students now.
