

Concluding the narrative of an extraordinary life, No Outspan recounts Reitz¢â ¬â,,¢s colourful adventures and endeavours as the long-drawn political struggle for South Africa continued. Deneys Reitz (1882-1944) was a Boer solider, lawyer, author and politician. From the day he enlisted in a commando to the Western Front and beyond, his lifeââ ¬â,¢s work would be devoted to South Africa. He married in 1920, and his wife would go on to become the first female member of the House of Assembly of South Africa. Commando and Trekking On are the first two volumes of his memoirs.
