

I ordered three of these for my children who are 11, 12 and 14. They are excited about it. In the front, it has instructions for using it for children as young as 5. I have 6 and 9 year old boys that I do not think are ready for it yet, but could imagine a 5 year old with a good attention span and interest to do well with it with parental involvement if siblings are also using it, as in a homeschool. The left pages have information about each element and a bit of history about it. The right pages are for coloring. It is about the difficulty you see on the cover. I have a copy of the microbiology coloring book. It is much, much more involved. I would use it for older high school students who are interested in the topic. Do be aware that the microbiology coloring book has information about STD's and also some drawings to color that are more of a PG13 nature.

My wife & I homeschool our children, and awhile back in an e-mail that I receive on a regular basis, this book was mentioned in it. It looked like it would be another great educational tool for our children, and it is. So, if you also homeschool your children this would be a great investment in their education.

This is a great book. We are going to use it this summer...pictures are clear, information is interesting. I like that she gives a fact page and a coloring page (that actually has space to color). My 11 and 13 year olds will enjoy doing this....because of the information, it doesn't seem "babyish" and the one son who doesn't enjoy coloring will just do the portion that he likes!

There are a few errors I have found in the text and pictures are basically clip art but a cute idea for introducing the elements

I use this to teach both my four year old and eight year old. The information is arranged in perfect snack size bits. I read the information to them while they color. They retain the information and listen without duct tape or candy bribes. The actual coloring sheets are not very elaborate but that is what makes it great. The simple images are just enough to add something visual to associate with each specific element without being overwhelming.
