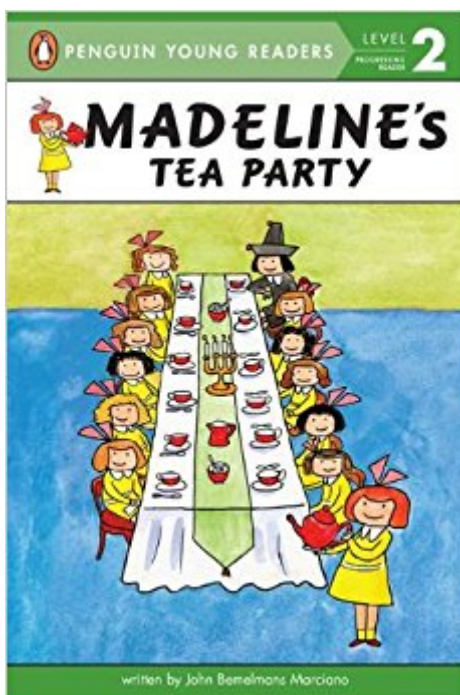

LOVE THIS! I love that this young readers book is actually by John Bemelmans Marciano (who I believe is the grandson of the Madeline creator). You can tell from the quality of the art and the writing that it's the real deal. Great reading exposure in a portable small format, but still authentic and wonderful Madeline.

This is a lovely addition to the Madeline group of books. As all those following the original, it begins with the typical "In an old house in Paris all covered with vines. . .", but then begins a new adventure.

This one introduces Pepito in which he tries to ruin the darling tea party hosted by Madeline. Sweet story and musical rhymes, as usual. It is not a hard cover book like many others; it is the less expensive paper version, but the price reflects it.

This book is a wonderful leveled reader. I love the penguin readers for my daughter who is in Kindergarten. This story is simple for the advanced Kindergartner to read and also has a storyline that can keep the kids interested. I hope they make more of these. The ending is very sweet and talks about forgiving a friend.

My granddaughter loves it and likes to have it read over and over.
