

Thich Nhat Hanh is one of the most revered Zen teachers in the world today. His best-selling books include Happiness and Peace Is Every Step. He lives in Plum Village in southwest France, where he teaches the art of mindful living. Illustrated by Vo-Dinh Mai and Nguyen Thi Hop.

There are some heart-warming and heart-breaking stories in this collection. "The Stone Boy" story is particularly moving while "The Lone Pink Fish" was a little challenging because it dealt with the great hardships of the refugees fleeing Vietnam during the conflict in the 1960s. If nothing else, this book may help the reader search for their inner compassion in understanding that there were a great many people who were trying to scratch out a living (or bare bones survival) during a most unfortunate time in Vietnam's history. And while there is still definitely great trauma that servicemen in the US still deal with even today, there is an equal amount of suffering that was experienced and has continued into subsequent generations in Thay's homeland.

So glad to be able to find a copy of these classic stories by Thich Nhat Hanh. They still resonate today. We will carry each other to the other shore in the boat of compassion.

Thich Nhat Hanh has again gone well above my expectations. When i first received this literature i was not excited about the idea of reading fiction on this topic, even though it was written by one of my favorite authors. However, these amazing short stories illustrate fundamental Buddhist teachings in a very creative, new, & fun format.
