

Karyn Henley, author of the original version of "The Beginner's Bible, " has developed this Bible for your young reader. Teach your child about God through his Word and help strengthen reading muscles at the same time by using the "Day by Day Begin-to-Read Bible."

Children's communicator Karyn Henley is the award-winning author of The Beginner's Bible, which has sold over four million copies and been translated into 17 languages. Specializing in materials for young readers, Karyn has published Day by Day Kids Bible, a chronological Bible; My First Hymnal, an easy-reading introduction to great hymns of the faith; the Playsongs video series for children ages 2 to 5; Before I Dream, which contains Bible stories and songs. Her resources for parents and teachers include Child Sensitive Teaching, Sword Fighting, Day by Day Devotions, Families Learning Together, and 100 Ways to Teach Your Child About God.

I gave this to my daughter for Christmas when she was in Kindergarten. She finished it in 1st grade. The content is appropriate for even a younger child, as her little sister listened nightly. She began reading it with help from me, but soon could read it herself except for names. She is a bit ahead on reading, so most 1st graders could read it without help (except for the names). My younger child is now reading it - with a lot of help. I expect in a few months though, that the help will greatly decrease. It makes a great nightly routine and one that my kids don't view as "reading a book". Most of the stories are only a page or two and there are many colorful drawings. It only has stories for Monday through Friday, so you can take the weekends off or the books suggest using another book. We took the weekends off, which seemed good for this age group. I can only remember one story that prompted an awkward conversation, but inevitably you will find many of those in Bible stories. It was not inappropriate for a 4-6 year old. I was happy with the book and would recommend it to others.

I have both this Bible for my 3 year old and the Young Readers one for my 7 year old. While I love the simplicity, it is almost too short and brief to really capture her attention. It might be better suited for a child who only likes super short Bible stories. It's not engaging enough for her, but the Young Readers version is way too complex.

We are on our second copy of this Bible. Yes, the stories are super short, but I have my early

readers read it on their own, so short is good. I wouldn't use this to read TO a child. 4 of my children have loved reading this Bible. However, both copies we have are totally falling apart. I wish it had a binding that would hold up to heavy use. We also have the older kids' version which is currently in use by the second person, and is beginning to fall apart as well.

This is a great bible for the beginner reader. My son is 7 and loves reading it every night. Each day has just a few paragraphs to read so he doesn't feel overwhelmed. The book has great illustrations also!
