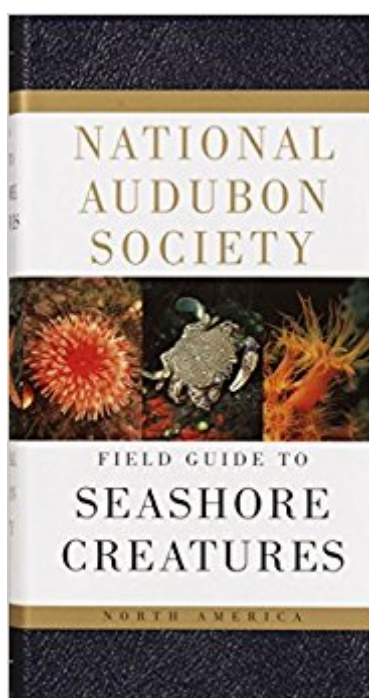

Each of the 690 identification pictures is a full-color photograph of a seashore creature.

Arrangement by shape and by color makes identification quick and easy. 666 species are covered in full detail.

The author, Norman A. Meinkoth, is Professor Emeritus of Zoology of Swarthmore College.

Not overly impressed with the layout. The pictures are in one section, and the information in

another. I worry that this could get annoying. I do like that the different creature types are split into categories, but more could probably be done to differentiate these sections, and/or the habitat type, location, etc). The small dust jacket is a bit odd and flimsy, but the book doesn't look very good without it either. I think the book will be useful, and pretty to flick through the pictures too, but these probably won't be my first choice for future field guides.
