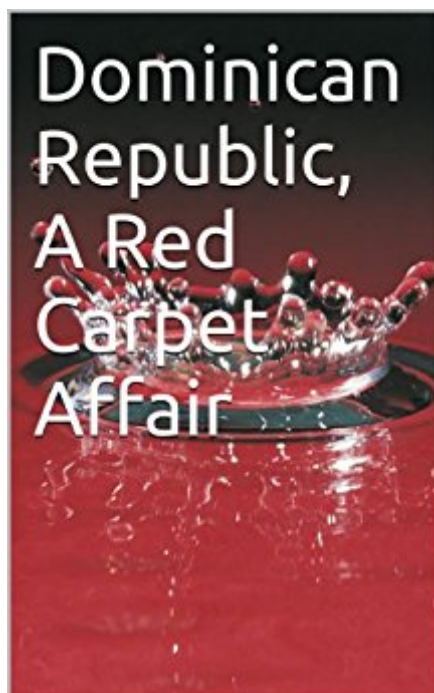

This was a short book about a man's first foray into the Dominican Republic. As an experienced traveller myself, I can appreciate the nuances of learning the ins and outs of a country upon first few days of arrival. Even though the book was a short read, it was too the point and lacking in the overly complicated prose that normally makes me fall asleep. The varied language was entertaining and the author even included a language key so you knew what he was saying when you read his slang words. Good for someone who wants a quick and dirty look at the Dominican Republic. I only docked one star as the formatting was sometimes a little choppy (the E-Book rearranges pictures and paragraphs which can be confusing) and a few words were misspelled. Unfortunately, I'm a bit of a grammar Nazi. That said - the book was worth its price. 10/10 Would buy again.
