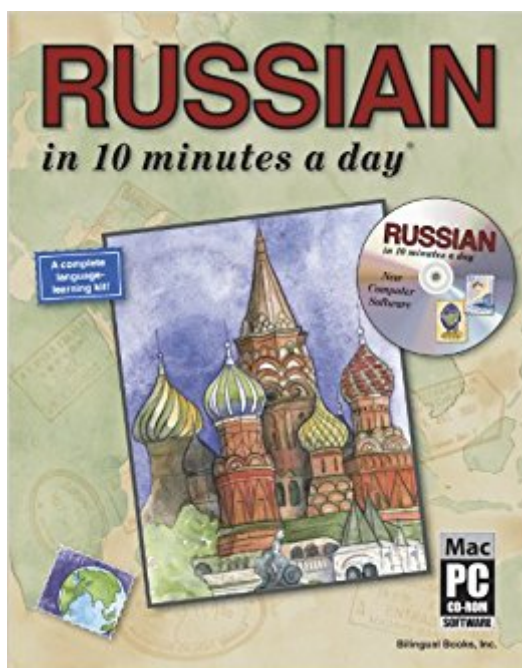

My husband and I each used a Learn Russian in Ten Minutes A Day workbook for just a month before a trip to Russia and it doubled our enjoyment of our trip! It gave us the ability to read Russian

well enough that my husband and I could depart from our escorted river tour, and take a public bus (the right one!), transfer to the Metro, get on and off at the right stations.....so that in addition to the half-day tour of the Hermitage offered by our tour, we were able to take off on our own to spend an additional 2 days at the museum and see wonderful things that the average Russian tourist has no time for. On tours through Moscow, St. Petersburg, etc. we could read the billboards, protest posters, storefront signs, and all those little things that give human insight in addition to what you are hearing from the official tour guide. The book is well designed to accommodate adult learning principles. I could not believe how well these simple and often entertaining exercises worked! Yes, I did use the stickers on my stuff; they were a great vocabulary aid. Yes, I did use the flash cards and other included tools and references. Learning is supposed to be fun, folks....and this was!

The book is okay but the CD-Rom is terrible to listen to. The voice on the CD counts the numbers from one to ten and above, in English. At first I thought I got the wrong CD, then checked the label to make sure it is for this book "Russian in 10 minutes a day". What a strange method teaching the Russian language. Two years ago, I bought the "Spanish in 10 minutes a day" book, both the book and the CD-Rom go together and I enjoyed learning the Spanish from that book very much. But this Russian book, in which it has similar lessons as those in the Spanish book, is not a very good deal because of the fact that it's a waste of time to listen to the CD-Rom.

I have bought the Spanish and German 10 minutes in a day with CD-ROM and I really liked those, because those CD-ROM actually had a native speaker walking you through each section of the book. This Russian CD-ROM was just some stickers and flash cards you can print out. No speech. Don't waste your money on this one. You really can learn a language good enough to speak and carry on in everyday life in just 10 minutes a day for 30 days. You will not be able to get a job with your language skills but you will have enough to be able to travel and have a simple conversation. I have tried pemsler and others, but I find this method works best. But you need to hear a native person speaking the language so you know how to pronounce it correctly.

For anyone who wants to begin learning Russian, I wouldn't recommend relying on this book exclusively - you've got to have some language tapes or other means of aural study - but it makes for a nice compliment to more traditional texts. Of course, the "10 minutes a day" concept is silly. However, when study time comes around, I find myself turning to this book more than any other, especially when I only have a little time to study or when I've had a particularly draining day and

don't feel up to more serious endeavors. The stickers are great, and I've found the pronunciations to be pretty accurate. It is a definite flaw that they don't show you the stressed vowels, but the individual pronunciations do account for the differences between stressed and unstressed vowels. On its own, this book isn't going to teach you Russian, but it is a fun and accessible supplemental study tool.

I love the book. The setup of the book, fun methods of learning, colorful pictures, online learning "games", flash cards, stickers for vocabulary, etc. all make this an excellent book. I'm very glad I bought it.

Great book for beginning vocabulary memorization. This book helped me get some of the basics of Russian down before moving to Russia to work for a year. I liked the methodology of this book. The included flash cards are very helpful. Definitely recommend for beginners!

The CD did not follow the pages in the book, common phrases used in every day communication were not there, the format was like using an old tape with no games or visual help, etc. The book has sticky labels you are suppose to use to label items in your house so you can practice the words, but they are only in Russian -- without English where am I suppose to stick them? A better choice would be Let's Talk Russian by EuroTalk. The only thing I got from this book was a tear-out menu guide and a few words
