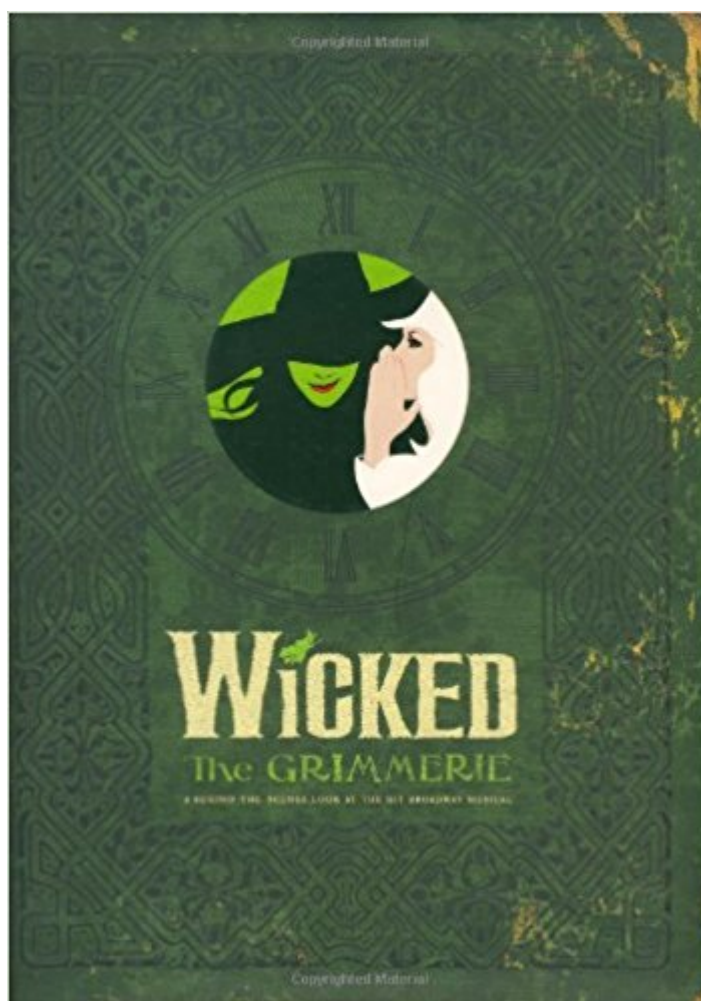

You can buy a book called *Wicked, The Broadway Musical* by Winnie Holzman with the story told in the musical. If you want to read the story of *Wicked*, I highly recommend Ms. Holzman's book over the original story by Mr. Maguire. I do not have anything against Mr. Maguire personally. His story is quite imaginative, possibly even brilliant, and has the same very interesting themes as those portrayed in the musical. Mr. Maguire's story is just too dark, too pornographic and too depressing for me. I prefer the much happier ending of the play. I know that life does not always have a happy ending but that is precisely why I like my fantasy to end in a cheery way.

"*Wicked: The Grimmerie*" offers a behind-the-scenes story of the Broadway musical from Gregory Maguire's 1995 novel, "*Wicked: The Life and Times of the Wicked Witch of the West*", to the adoration the play eventually garnered from fans. "*The Grimmerie*" explores casting choices, the difficulties in translating the characters' backstories to the stage and the challenges in creating the ideal songs to express this, the writers' struggles with how faithful they needed to be to the novel while still telling a good story, the creation of sets, costumes, make-up, and lighting, and more. The book also helps to set the musical within the context of other adaptations of Baum's novels, explaining what elements from the books made it in to the play. Fans of *Oz*, Maguire's novels, or the musical will delight in this behind-the-scenes book.
