

His books for children include >, > (with Eric Carle), and > (with Alex Williams). Eric Carle was born in Syracuse, New York, and moved to Germany with his parents when he was six years old. He studied at the Academy of Graphic Arts in

Stuttgart before returning to the United States, where he worked as a graphic designer for > and later as art director for an international advertising agency. His first two books, > and >, gained him immediate international recognition. The latter title, now considered a modern classic, has sold more than 30 million copies and has been translated into forty-eight languages. Eric Carle and his wife, Barbara, divide their time between the mountains of North Carolina and the Florida Keys.
