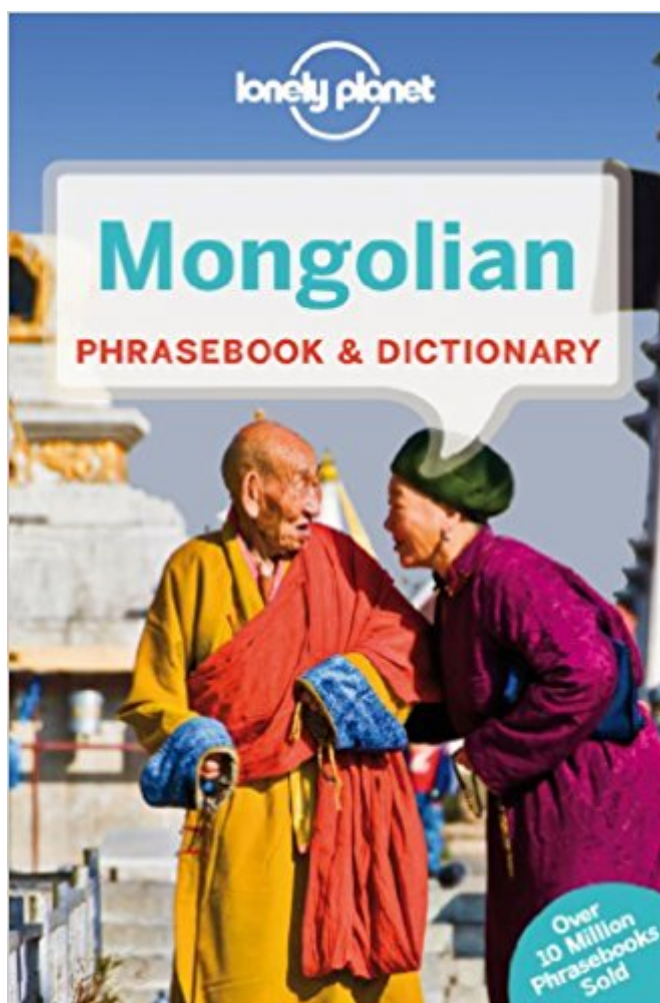

I was looking for a book with key phrases for a traveler, probably using an easy phonetic approach. But, no.....that would be too easy. The approach is more traditional: let's learn pronunciation, then a fair amount of Mongolian grammar, and only then do we go to categories of phrases like Greeting, Small Talk, Accommodation, etc. The Language section of the Lonely Planet Mongolia (Travel Guide) is probably a better bet for my purposes.

Mongolian seems so complicated, with its Cyrillic alphabet (35 characters?!), blizzard of consonants, and opaque pronunciation. I'm afraid I'll be reduced to pointing at the book, although I had hoped to be able to actually speak a bit. I wish this book had come with a CD, but it does seem to be comprehensive and well-organized.

The pronunciation given for each word, phrase or sentence makes this a handy text for anyone who cannot read the Cyrillic alphabet. It's great for travel or study.
