

Richard Boleslavsky was a member of the Moscow Art Theater and cofounder of the American Laboratory Theater School, which trained Lee Strasberg and Stella Adler among other actors and teachers, playing an important role in bringing Stanislavsky's techniques to America. Although he directed Hollywood films in the 1930s and 1940s, his enduring work is contained in this book.

Clearly a classic study of the Stanislavsky method and the first outline of it specifically for the western actor. But these days there are books out there that give you a much more in-depth explanation of Stanislavsky's acting tools and how to use them. Although, I did like the premise and structure of "a play within a book". That made it a slight delight to read. All in all it's helpful if you want to see what was going on during that time. His translation of Stanislavsk's tools is what the creators of The Method (Strasberg and Clurman) were drawing on.
