

I have now read eight of Jean Craighead George's Thirteen Moons books, and this is one of my favorites. The series, written for children in the middle grades but enjoyable for anyone, features a particular animal in his native habitat in a given month of the year. The Moon of the Mountain Lions is the August moon, and the mountain lions in the story live on and around Mount Olympus in Washington State. Near the timberline in August we see animals already thinking of winter and making preparations, and we watch a lion travel from the mountains and forests through alpine meadows and finally to the seacoast in search of a mate. The most outstanding features of the Thirteen Moons books are the spectacular illustrations--full-page colored paintings, in this case, by

Ron Parker. This book has some of the most beautiful paintings in the series, including scenes of a waterfall in the forest, a deer in a meadow below snowy peaks, a mountain lion on a rock in the moonlight, and a meadow of flowers by a river. Whoever you are, whatever your age, don't miss these pictures. And adults just might enjoy the story, too.
