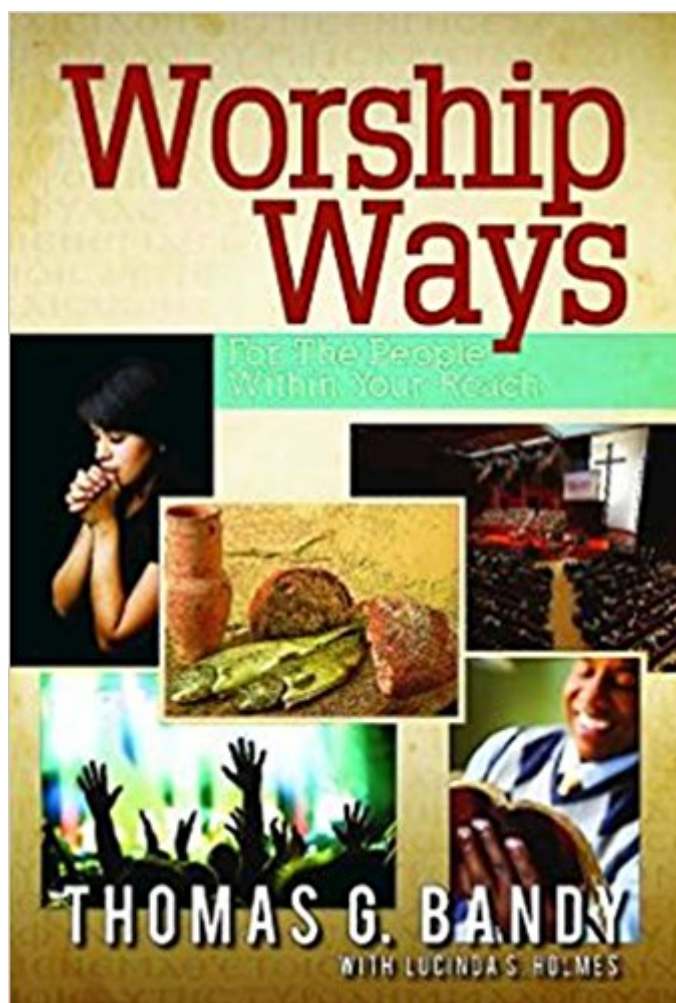

Bandy makes a lot of good points and the book could be a good tool for those working on changes to worship style. It makes some assumptions that aren't backed up in the text but might be covered in one of his earlier works. This book, however, doesn't make me want to go back and read any of them. His definitions and examples are good as are his conclusions even if you don't accept his base premise. If you are looking to change styles, this would be one of the books to use but I wouldn't suggest it as the only one.

Great book especially for those who have already delved into missioninsight stats. It is marketing oriented but very readable and applicable to any church setting and style. Well worth the time and cost!
