

If you are one of those people who thinks good cybersecurity is a cost you cannot afford, then you need to read this book. Most of the tips and tools described inside likely won't cost you anything;

effective cybersecurity starts with having the right mindset (information security awareness) and then careful planning around what you need to secure. Raef will not try to convince you that his book is the be-all and end-all for information security, but for the home and small business owner, this book will cover the most prevalent risks you are likely to face and provide pragmatic advice to protect yourself; with clear definitions throughout so you do not get lost in technobabble. A previous reviewer mentioned this is not a long book. It is not, but again, that is a good thing. Securing your private and important information should not be a chore; as soon as it becomes a chore it may get neglected or ignored. This book is clear and concise, and within a short time will leave you with the tools needed to implement an effective set of defenses against the most common threat actors. And don't forget to keep it close to hand as an excellent reference, as the advice presented within is unlikely to go out of date anytime soon.

As someone running a small business from home this is a really useful book! It is well set out and easy to understand, it gets to the practical actions I can take without me having to have a computing degree or read a huge volume (which I don't get time for!). Any technical terms in here are well explained. I can also easily share my new knowledge with the kids so that our home network - and by extension my business - is not compromised! I felt that this book had been tailored for me and others like me whose home and business computers/ networks are not separate and who do not have the time or the money to get specialist advice or protection. A good investment in my business - reasonably priced and not too long to read!
