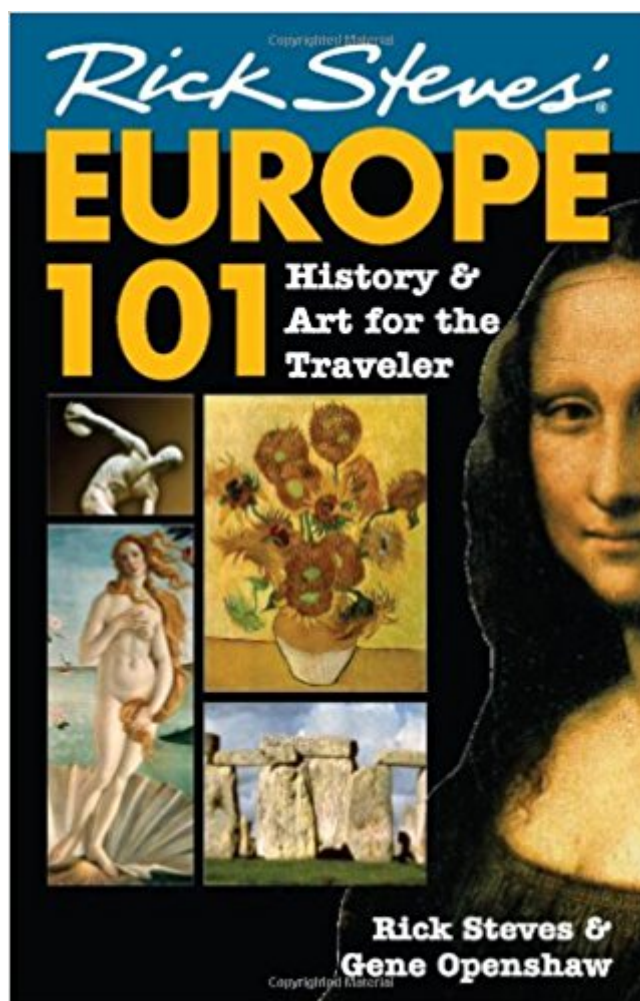

He lives near Seattle with his daughter, and roots for the Mariners in good times and bad. Since 1973, Rick Steves has spent about four months a year exploring Europe. His mission: to empower Americans to have European trips that are fun, affordable, and culturally broadening. Rick produces a best-selling guidebook series, a public television series, and a public radio show, and organizes small-group tours that take over 20,000 travelers to Europe annually. He does all of this with the help of a hardworking, well-traveled staff of 100 at Rick Steves' Europe in Edmonds, Washington, near Seattle. When not on the road, Rick is active in his church and with advocacy groups focused on economic justice, drug policy reform, and ending hunger. To recharge, Rick plays piano, relaxes at his family cabin in the Cascade Mountains, and spends time with his partner Trish, son Andy, and daughter Jackie.

If you're looking for a quick orientation history of Europe, this book will do the trick. Just as Rick explains in the book's intro and description, it is oriented towards the traveler. I read this before a three week tour of Europe and am so glad I did- it gave me a working knowledge of the basics of European history, providing a framework in which to understand the significance and history of what I was seeing on my tour. Well written, with just enough humor to keep it interesting. I would recommend it to anyone looking to brush up on their European history! It does fizzle out at the end, particularly the second half of the 20th century. The last chapter, on Europe today, isn't worth reading. But the rest of the book is EXCELLENT!

I have read this book and sent several copies to my friends as gift. Really good book for travelers to Europe, widely covering arts related to popular attractions. Recommended.
