

The Wide Window by Lemony Snicket was a wonderful novel. The vocabulary that the author uses can be uncommon, which allows for deeper thinking by students. Many students are familiar with

the way in which an author writes a story. This author is able to change things up and require the reader to think more critically. Throughout the book the author uses exemplary imagery in order to portray his views. Snicket focuses on creating an image for the reader. This is useful for students that are mastering the metacognitive skill of image making. The reader is also given the opportunity to use the questioner meta cognitive skill throughout the novel. Snicket provides several thought provoking questions in his writing which helps students begin this process. As a future teacher this series is a useful resource to use. The many features that promote metacognitive learning techniques are what make this novel great.

My children love this series. Each book is a new adventure, and this series is great as a read-aloud.
